Spellings:

For year 3, 8 words: 6 spelling pattern words and 2 Yr3/4 common exception words.

Your child has a Times Table Rock Star (TTRS) login to practise their times table facts. Please encourage your child to practise as frequently as possible. Weekly competitions will be set up with the opportunity to be awarded certificates.
