Each week we will explore a key theme related to our visions and values of love, hope and truth (a half-term on each, twice a year) Key links to bible stories and verses will be made each week and clear applications made for children to understand and apply what they have learnt in the day-to-day life both within St James' but also in their wider communities.	This assembly will be used to launch the key theme for the week. It will introduce a bible verse for and give a framework for class worship. As the week moves on, look for opportunities to exemplify and encourage the weekly theme. For example, "Well done, you have really demonstrated a patient heart this week."	Class worship will be led by the teacher each week in your own classroom. This is an opportunity to reflect with your class on the visions and values assembly. The key verse can be used to help explore the key theme and get children talking about the message they heard the day before.	We are privileged to have our local clergy and Open the Book visiting the school each week. They will take a weekly collective worship for the whole school and will highlight key events in the Christian calendar. Open the Book explores some key biblical stories from throughout the bible and where appropriate, we will link these into our key themes for the week.	This will happen on a weekly basis and is an opportunity to future explore our theme for the week. Where possible, songs will link to the theme for the week.	Our celebration assembly will be used to reflect on our week, talk about how we learnt from our theme and celebrate the individual and collective successes of each week.
