They will take a weekly collective worship for the whole school and will highlight key events in the Christian calendar. Open the Book explores some key biblical stories from throughout the bible and where appropriate, we will link these into our key themes for the week.	Class worship will be led by the teacher each week in your own classroom. This is an opportunity to reflect with your class on the visions and values assembly. The key verse can be used to help explore the key theme and get children talking about the message they heard the day before.	Our celebration assembly will be used to reflect on our week, talk about how we learnt from our theme and celebrate the individual and collective successes of each week.
